



ALLAN BEEBER



Allan Beeber, Rev., Ph.D. is the Orlando director of Global Media Outreach (GMO), an Internet ministry with headquarters in Silicon Valley. He has been on staff for almost three decades.

He directed the campus ministry at M.I.T. in Boston from 1979 to 1986, which grew to become one of the largest per capita ministries on the East Coast. In the late 1980's, Beeber launched the Student LINC ministry, both directly and indirectly responsible for the creation of 2,500 catalytic movements worldwide.

In the mid 1990's, Beeber began turning his attention to the use of the Internet for ministry. Today the Orlando GMO team is responsible for the development of over 200 websites, including the No. 1 rated "[Who is Jesus ... Really?](#)" and "[The Evangelism Toolbox.](#)"

Beeber is currently leading the Orlando GMO efforts on developing a flexible, rules plus, modular-based, open source, translatable, measurement-oriented response system (named "ARC") which can easily be attached to any evangelism or discipleship site, with contacts distributed automatically to online volunteers' virtual mailboxes around the world with built-in, rules-based aging features. Beeber and the GMO team have developed what may be the Christian world's best online response system for Christian evangelism and discipleship.

Beeber is married to Tricia, and they have three children.
